In 2015 God blessed us in so many ways I could fill this whole report with stories of God's goodness and grace. For the sake of space I am limiting myself to a few things:

- 1) Thanks to Todd Neighbor of Cedar Valley Physical Therapy, we were able to start physical therapy services. We could even use another PT if you know someone to refer!
- 2 Thanks to the University of Northern Iowa and Mount Mercy University for helping us start a pilot program providing social work services.
- 3) Thanks to Dr. Jolynn Glanzer, Christie Hinds, ARNP and Dr. Jerome Janda we are able to have two daytime clinics each week with at least two providers. This is how we were able to increase the number of patients served in 2015 by 13.6 percent.



Every day we're given the chance to make a difference in the lives of our patients.

When we first met Kelly, she had found out she needed several blood tests done, but before that could happen she had lost her insurance. With the encouragement of her husband, she came to the clinic as a last resort.

"I've been raised to work for what you get," she said. "My family was experiencing tough times. My back was up against the wall, so I came [to the clinic].

What she found was a place where she was more than a number. She was loved and cared for and she encountered staff and volunteers who were able to provide exactly what she needed.

> > As a result of her visit, Kelly was able to get her blood work done for free through Mercy Hospital and she was able to receive the medication that she needed through His Hands.

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) is now 2 years old, but His Hands still deals with the constant changes affecting the health care landscape. In 2015, we actually experienced an increase of 14 percent, or 159 patients, from 2014.

So, how is it possible that His Hands is seeing more patients when the ACA is supposed to make sure everyone has access to affordable health care? We have seen that very low income individuals qualify for free insurance with the ACA and Medicaid expansion, but individuals who are working face many barriers:


• Sometimes they make too much money one month so they lose their insurance. Then it often takes 30-45 days to have it reinstated.

- Some employers are too small to be required to offer insurance.
- Some individuals are paying for catastrophic policies with \$10,000 deductibles, and can pay the premiums but are unable to pay for routine medical care and a \$200 office visit.
- Some patients have moved and are waiting for their health care benefits to start at their new job.
- Some patients are refugees and do not yet have insurance.
- Some patients have insurance but are finding it is a two month wait to be able to see their new primary care provider.


In all these cases, we are standing in the gap and providing services for patients who need medical care. Our social work pilot program is helping patients receive health insurance, find a primary care physician and address Medicaid issues.

We are also helping patients find resources for basic needs such as food, clothing and shelter, and we have helped patients work through issues related to disabilities, aging, finding prescription assistance and counseling.
